

Janusz Poliński: National Plans for the Implementation of PRM TSI on Selected European Railways – Czech and Slovak Railways

The article features the Czech and Slovak National Plan for the Implementation of the Technical Specification for Interoperability PRM. Data sets related to the plan are preceded by information concerning the population of people with disabilities in both countries. Further, the existing condition of the Czech and Slovak rail infrastructure as well as the rolling stock used in long-distance and local traffic are presented. The action plan indicates the scope of anticipated work to improve the accessibility of passenger railway stations and the rolling stock. A separate chapter concerns the principles to finance work related to improving the accessibility of rail transport for the disabled.
