Iwona Wróbel: Northern Agglomeration Railway

The information describes a project carried out at the Railway Track and Operations Department of the Railway Research Institute, concerning analyses of the Northern Agglomeration Railway (Północna Kolej Aglomeracyjna – PKA) variants with respect to the possibility of serving the northern districts of Gdynia and neighbouring communes by rail transport. The project took into account previous studies carried out after 2000 which included variants of the route of the line and the location of railway stations and stops for the area of the Tricity metropolis. The studies and analyses resulted in an expert assessment report of potential variants of the PKA line, indicating the advantages and disadvantages of individual solutions and containing recommendations in technical and operational aspects.
